This requirement **MUST** be met by the end of 3rd quarter.

GPA - grade point average

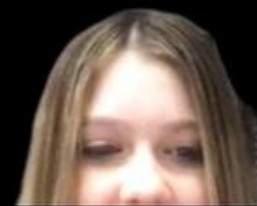
