Curriculum

Credits

- Seven credits are required for earning the diploma:
 - 1 credit each from Groups 1, 2, and 3,
 - 3 credits distributed across the groups in any desired combination.
 - The last credit is earned through Cambridge International AS Level Global Perspectives & Research
 - Optionally, up to 2 credits may be taken from Group 4, the interdisciplinary and Skills-Based subjects group

Exams

- Passing an AS Level exam (corresponding to a one-year course) earns you 1 credit
- Passing an A Level exam (corresponding to a two-year course) earns you 2 credits.

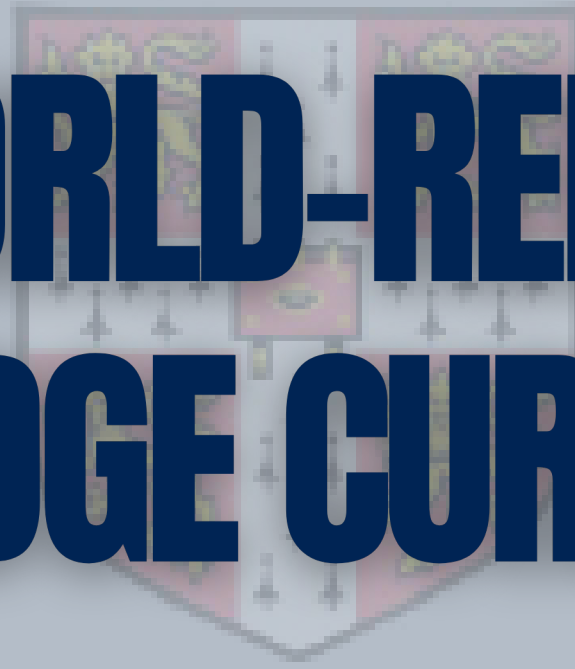
You must take all exams within a 25-month period.

Benefits

- ✓ Individual course certificates can also earn you college credit if you don't earn the diploma.
- ✓ Completing the diploma and 100 hours of community service automatically nets you the Florida Academic Scholarships Award via the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program.
- ✓ Can earn students recognition, college credit, and scholarship money at certain schools, and it's also an excellent way to further your education all around.

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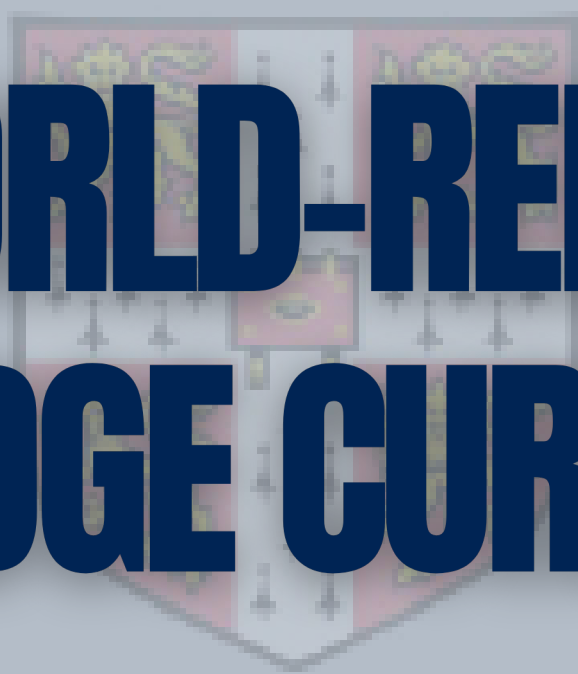
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
