


Expectations for Online Learning

It takes a degree of self-motivation, discipline, and time management for students to succeed in a virtual environment and we are here to provide support every step of the way. Your classes are conducted live on Blackboard Collaborate, with your classroom teacher, each and every day. Students will follow the behavior expectations and norms outlined in our Student Handbook.

Each course has its own link in D2L and everything you need to know about your course, in order to succeed, will be found within the course. You will find:

- Your daily assignments and drop box links
- Course textbooks and class material
- Resources
- Links to Blackboard Collaborate

REGULAR, ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IS REQUIRED



You are expected to log into your class on time; participate in each activity; ask and answer questions; work collaboratively and/or independently; and turn on your camera when speaking. In other words, you must be an "active" learner.

As you know, we are a uniform school, however during online learning, you do not need to wear you school uniform, but you do need to wear attire appropriate and acceptable for school. Students should not be wearing pajamas or other inappropriate clothing. Parents, we will need your help with this.

BASIC NETIQUETTE

- Attend class daily if you are absent for any reason, it is YOUR responsibility to reach out to your teacher to determine what was missed
- Arrive on time / do not leave early
- Be involved and actively participate in class discussions
- Establish a good distraction-free space to work. Use headphones to focus on instruction
- Be polite and respectful in both language and behavior
- Use good grammar and correct spelling in chat box (do not use all caps and do not use text slang)
- Check your course pages daily. This includes your homepage, calendar & assignment page, and course syllabus
- Keep up with your assignments and turn them in on time
- Pay attention to quiz/test dates
- Communicate with your teachers read and respond to Outlook email
- Review teacher feedback and check grades regularly
- Seek out help. Reach out to your teachers if you need assistance
- Practice good time management. Don't procrastinate
- Be patient with yourself, your classmates and your teacher
- Support one another in this new way of learning we are in this together!

PARENT'S ROLE

Help your child establish a daily routine and/or schedule for attending classes and completing assignments after school. Ensure that your child has the tools they need for success. Check in with your child and ask how they are doing. Remind them to contact their teacher if they are having any difficulty or have questions and encourage your child to keep in touch with their classmates and friends.



Broward County Public Schools Food and Nutrition Services

Grab-and-Go meals are available for students every Tuesday and Thursday from 10 AM -1PM starting on August 19th through September 4th. Meal service will also be offered on Wednesday, August 19th, the first day of school. Students or their parents will be able to pick up multiple meals at a time.

Students must have identification to receive meals. Recommended forms of identification include student ID's, report cards, and birth certificates. Families are encouraged to pick up student meals from their base school for ease of service.

Meal prices will be based on each student's eligibility. Apply for Free and Reduced priced meals at myschoolapps.com. Families are encouraged to pay online for student meals through myschoolbucks.com.
