### What is the IB Middle Years Programme (MYP)?

The IB-MYP is designed for students aged 11 to 16. It provides a framework of learning that encourages students to become creative, critical, and reflective thinkers. The MYP emphasizes intellectual challenge that encourages students to make connections with their studies in traditional subjects and the real world. It fosters the development of skills for communication, intercultural understanding and global engagement,
