

ACADEMIC PATHWAYS FOR EVERY STUDENT

Cambridge Scholars Pathway

For motivated, high-achieving students who plan on participating in honors & AP courses, or dual enrollment while in high school. This is our most academically challenging path and requires parent and teacher recommendation as well as a strong academic history.

Cambridge Soaring Eagles Pathway

Designed to challenge academically talented students who want to focus on academics as well as other interest-based activities. We recognize that many of our students are gifted and talented in the technical areas of the curriculum and may be highly involved in afterschool activities.

Cambridge Rising Eagles Pathway

This pathway is for students who are striving to achieve grade-level mastery and need extra support in the areas of literacy and math. Students on this pathway are given extra academic support courses and mentorship to continue to grow socially and academically.
