



Teachers should be flexible and take into account the individual student's circumstance for attendance. Please keep in contact with your child's teacher.







I Ready Diagnostic Assessments

Starting next week, Wednesday September 9th, we will be administering the I ready diagnostic assessments in reading and math for all students in K-5. i-Ready is an online program for reading and/or mathematics that will help your student's teacher(s) determine your student's needs, personalize their learning, and monitor progress throughout the school year. The diagnostic assessment will help us determine what your child's needs are in reading and math and then help us to set a path to address those needs.

Here are some ways you can help your child prepare for the assessment:



Get organized

by finding a quiet space for your student to take the test and confirming your technology is working properly.



Motivate your child

by explaining how doing their best will help their teachers know how to teach them better.



Support, but DO NOT help

by encouraging your child to stay focused and try their best and NOT helping them with the answers.



Celebrate your child's effort

once you have confirmed they have completed the assessment.
