Dismissal Procedures and Student Pick-up

This year we will continue to implement a color code system to help streamline our dismissal process. All students will be assigned a color based for their primary means of dismissal. Please take a few minutes to review our 🛟 plan.

RED AREA
If your child gets picked up in a car using the car loop on Miami road, your child will be considered a "car rider" and will be color-coded with a RED wristband on their backpack.

GREEN AREA
If your child gets picked up by an adult who parks their car and/or walks to on campus to meet their child at the end of the day, please meet your child at the west side of the campus near the marquee area. Your child will be considered a "walker" and will be color-coded with a GREEN wristband on their backpack.

BLUE AREA
If your child rides a school bus, your child will be considered a "bus rider" and will be color-coded with a BLUE wristband on their backpack. (This will include all students who participate in aftercare programs that provide transportation to aftercare site.)

YELLOW AREA
If your child participates in the Sunshine Aftercare program, your child will be considered "aftercare" and they will be color-coded with a YELLOW wristband on their backpack. At the end of the school day, all aftercare students will be escorted to the cafeteria.
