Boys' Uniform Standard Bottoms

Pants	Shorts	Clarifications
Trouser style/cargo style with a belt Jeans(black, khaki, or gray only, no blue jeans)	Any style with a belt, unless elasticized Black, Khaki, Navy Blue, Gray only	No white bottoms NO BLUE JEAN PE shorts cannot be worn as a school uniform bottom.

Boy's Required Tops

Shirts	Colors	Clarifications
Polo, Rugby or Oxford style – long or short sleeve	(Solid) black, white, gray, blue, khaki, and school approved striped combinations	PE t-shirts cannot be worn as a school uniform top. T-shirts cannot be worn as a school uniform top.

Girls' Required Bottoms

Pants	Shorts, Skirts, and Skorts	Clarifications
Trouser style/cargo style with a belt, Jeans(black, khaki, navy blue, or gray only)	Any style with a belt, unless elasticized Black, Khaki, Navy Blue, Gray only Must comply with the length policy of the Broward County School Board Dress Code	No white bottoms NO BLUE JEANS No stretch pants No form fitting pants PE shorts cannot be worn as a school uniform bottom.

Girl's Required Tops

<u>Shirts</u>	<u>Colors</u>	<u>Clarifications</u>
Polo, Rugby or Oxford style – long or short sleeve T-shirts cannot be worn as school uniform top.	(Solid) black, white, gray, blue, khaki, and school approved Striped Combinations	T-shirts cannot be worn as a school uniform top. PE t-shirts cannot be worn as a school uniform top.

Additional Considerations

<u>Shirts</u>	<u>Pants/Shorts</u>	<u>Undershirts</u>
ALL SHIRTS MUST HAVE A COLLAR	The bottoms may not have any designs NO WHITE BOTTOMS	Visible undershirts: blue, khaki, or white (only) T-Shirts/ undershirts may not hang beyond or below the uniform shirt

<u>Jackets/Sweaters</u>	<u>Shoes</u>	<u>School ID</u>
Only plain blue, black, white, khaki, or gray hoodies, pullovers, or sweaters allowed (if worn, uniform collar must be visible on the outside)	Closed toed, closed heel shoes, at all times NO SLIDES or CROCS at any time!	School ID must be worn around the neck at all times. Students will be provided an ID Badge and allowed free replacements up to three times. After the third replacement, there is a \$5 student obligation fee.

Cold Weather Consideration: On days where the weather is **below 60 degrees**, students may wear **plain** sweatpants. These pants **MUST** comply with the uniform policy and colors, **black, gray, khaki, or navy blue** only. Students who wear sweatpants with stripes, designs or colors other than what is listed above, will receive a uniform violation.

School Spirit Shirts: Students may wear school spirit shirts on **Fridays only**.
