Rules and Expectations:

1. **RESPECT** yourself, your fellow cadets and the instructors, ALWAYS!
2. Sharpen pencils and have study materials ready before class begins. All students should have a binder available to maintain study materials and hand-outs.
3. Cadets will be in the classroom before the tardy bell rings.
4. Cadets must dress out for physical training in the PT uniform and tennis shoes (no flipflops/slides/house shoes).
5. Cadets must wear their uniforms the WHOLE Day on Wednesday/ Thursday uniform days.
7. Male Cadets will not wear earrings and will be clean shaven while wearing the JROTC uniform per Cadet Command Regulation (CCR) 145-2.
8. All Cadets will have their hair styles in accordance with CCR 145-2. Failure to get a haircut, and/or ignore the regulation, will result in a zero for the weekly uniform inspection grade.
9. Every class will start with cadets reciting the Pledge of Allegiance and the JROTC Creed. Cadets will memorize and recite both.
10. Cadets will remove all headgear and earphones/ earbuds when they enter the room.
11. Cadets will not use their cell phones while in class, unless authorized by the teacher.
12. Cadets will respect the student leadership and follow their instructions the same way they would follow the teacher's instructions.

Uniform Regulations:

The Army JROTC ASU uniform will be worn here at the Eagles Battalion. We encourage cadets, as well as their parents, to look over the attached images so that our cadets can look professional on the days that we wear the uniform.
