Where to



- □ ELLs with inconsistent data will require an ELL Committee Meeting to determine EXIT or Continued Placement. For students who exit: PLAN and EXIT Date (Date of ELL Committee Meeting), Basis of exiting (L), Tier Placement (Z).
- □ ELL Plan dates (A23) are updated to the first day of School for LY students ONLY K-12. (Reminder, ELL Plan Date is updated often throughout the school year).
- □ For NEW students entering BCPS for the first time and qualify for ESOL Program Services update: **A03**: LY, LC, DEUSS; **A23**: CLASS, Entry, PLAN, Basis of Entry, Tier Placement; **A21**: Enter IPT data.
- □ For students transferring/matriculating from other Broward Schools, there is a <u>form</u> for requesting ELL Plans from transferring schools. Provide ESOL Contacts Academic History (**A07**) along with the Home Language Survey upon registration. PLAN Date is updated to reflect the first day at your school for **LY students** (**A23**).


NEW English Language Learner (ELL) Status Code "LP" (Potential ELLs Pending Assessment)

Based on the response(s) to the Home Language Survey (HLS), potential ELLs enrolled in the district will be coded "LP" on the ELL status code field on the AO3 Panel of TERMS.

- Student is enrolled in grades KG-12.
- Student has "Yes" marked on any of the three HLS questions.
- Student is pending initial ESOL program placement assessment.

- 1 * New* ELL Status: LP code
- 2 Student Language
- 3 Parent Language
- **4** Country Code
- 5 Language Survey Date
- 6 DEUSS Date (Date of Entry in the United States School)
- **7** Birthplace







ELL Codes

Code

Definition

- LY The student is an English Language Learner and enrolled in classes specifically designed for ELLs.
- **LF** The student is being monitored for a two-year period after having exited from the ESOL Program.
- The student has completed the two-year follow-up period after exiting the ESOL program (code LF) and is reported in this category for the next two years (years 3-4 after exiting) for the purpose of student subgroup reporting per the state ESSA plan.
- The student is one for whom a four (4) year follow-up period has been completed after the student has exited the ESOL Program.
- Not applicable (for the ESOL Program).
- **LY-T** The student is a temporary Language Learner, placed in Program based on a "Yes" response to the Home Language Survey, **only used for Pre-K students**.



Students in grades **Kg-12th** with a "**Yes**" marked on any of the 3 HLS questions and pending the English proficiency assessment (IPT) will be coded "**LP**" (Potential "ELL) in the ELL field on TERMs **A03 panel**.





Plan Date

PLAN dates must be updated at the beginning of each school year to reflect the child's <u>first day of school</u> and to indicate instructional program recommendation. LY students only (K-12).

<u>Update</u> the <u>PLAN date</u> when the following changes occur:

- **♦**ESOL services
- ♦ Language Classification
- ♦An English Language Learner (ELL) Committee is convened
- ♦ Annual Reviews and REEVALs based on anniversary date (DEUSS)
- ♦Classes or courses
- ◆If any changes are made to <u>classes</u>, <u>courses</u>, or <u>ESOL services</u> the ESOL Contact must be notified in order for a new ELL Plan to be generated

It is essential that updates are completed in a timely manner for ESOL Contacts and your school to be in compliance.


Incoming Pre-K Students






Identified based on HLS

- LY on A03 Panel until Kindergarten
- Temporary A23 Panel
- Basis of Entry = "T"
- Class, Entry and Plan Date (same date as Home Language Survey)







•Students previously enrolled in BCPS who leave for **90** school days or more and return are required to be reassessed with the IDEA Proficiency Test (IPT) for ESOL Services.



- •Every measure should be taken to honor time in an ESOL Program, and the original ENTRY date should **not be** modified.
 - ◆Update the PLAN date
 - Changes in TERMS should be made as quickly as possible in order for them to be reflected in ELLevation



Immigrant Information

- is between the ages 3-21; and office the columbia of the state of of the stat

Note: The children of U.S. military personnel born overseas are to be included in any count of immigrant children or youth.





Important!

- Although IMTs do not need to enter or update immigrant status, please make sure that the DEUSS date and country codes are correct.
- Only students born in the U.S. or Puerto Rico are NOT ELIGIBLE for immigrant status
 - BUT students born in the other U.S. territories are eligible for immigrant status (Johnston Atoll, Marshall Islands, any US Virgin Islands).
- A weekly sweep will be done by the IT Department.





Dual Language Program

Dual Language

For the 2023-2024 school year, ELLs (LY) who are enrolled in a Dual Language Program, must have:

- "T" code on the A10 panel in the target Language Arts course
- An active A23 panel
- Must be coded LY on the A03 panel



Transferring Students



- Provide the ESOL Contact academic history(A07 panel) at the time of registration for students transferring within BCPS.
- Data from previous county in Florida must be entered for LY, LF and LA students.
- ELL PLAN Date is updated to reflect the student's attendance at your school for LY students.
- For students transferring from another school in the U.S, provide which District and/or state the student is transferring from.
- Previous school is contacted to obtain as much information as possible (e.g. Initial Placement, ACCESS for ELLs scores).
- ELL Plan date is updated to reflect the student's attendance at your school for LY students.

Continuation of Common Data Errors

Commonly Confused Country/Languages Codes

- Ukraine's country code is UA not UK (United kingdom)
- •Jamaica's country code is JM not JA (Japan)
- Venezuela's country code is VE not VN (Vanuatu)
- Bahama's country code is BF not BH (Bhutan)



REMEMBER:

For the United States Commonwealth and Territories enter the the country code, **do not use US.**

- •French Creole and Haitian Creole's language code is HC not FC (Fox)
- •French Cree's language code is FD not HC (Haitian Creole)
- Portuguese language code is PR not PO (Polish)
- •Hebrew's language code is **HE not HB** (Haida)

Do not use CREOLE (ZF) in place of Haitian Creole



Note: Incorrect Coding may impact funding and grant opportunities.
