

## Hospital Homebound Notes:

Hospital Homebound is a Special Education Service. These students are owned by the boundary school and will stay enrolled at your location on the A03. The A10 schedule will be put in by me and I will update the A23. If you are a charter school, then I will be contacting you to update the A10 and A23.

Full-time Hospital Homebound students will only have my courses on the A10, which will be inputted by me. If you have a student at your location that was full-time Hospital Homebound last year, please purge your schedule off of the A10 before the first day of school. My schedules should be in by the end of next week. If you do not know of any students at your location that might be Hospital Homebound, please get with your ESE Specialist to get the names of these students or you can always contact me.

If the student is part-time Hospital Homebound, then I will contact the IMT's/IMS's and we will work on the A10 schedule together.

If the student is Intermittent Hospital Homebound, then the student will have your full school schedule on the A10. For every two days missed, our HH teachers will provide one hour of make-up services.

Hospital Homebound is always the primary exceptionality on the A23, whether the student is full-time, part-time, intermittent or consult. I will be updating this panel.

The Hospital Homebound students can have two matrixes at one time on the A23 if they are serviced in the home and on the computer, which is referred to tele-class.

In home Hospital Homebound students will have a matrix of 255.

Hospital Homebound Teleclass students which again is computer based students, will have a matrix of 252.

Intermittent and Part-time Hospital Homebound student will have a matrix of 251 or higher depending on students other eligibilities.
