

# FTE Requirements and Documentation

The purpose of this section is to provide guidance on requirements and documentation necessary to support the number of Full Time Equivalent (FTE) students that have been reported during the State's survey periods.

### 1. Membership

To receive funding for a student, the student must be **<u>enrolled</u>** in the school during the FTE survey week. Students withdrawn at any time prior to survey week cannot be considered for funding, even though they might have been in attendance prior to the survey week. The appropriate withdrawal code is shown on the day following the last day of membership. *Registration and withdrawal forms serve as documentation of whether a student is enrolled or withdrawn from your school.* 

### 2. Attendance

In addition to meeting membership requirements for FTE funding, a student must be **<u>physically present</u>** one of the days during survey week OR one of the six scheduled school days prior to survey week. Holidays and Teacher Workdays are excluded when counting back the six days.

### 3. Attendance Documentation

Attendance data must be entered on the TERMS student database. The Principal's Attendance Register for the FTE survey period must be signed by the principal and filed with other FTE documentation. To verify the accuracy of the database attendance, auditors will check the attendance documentation source, such as: Pinnacle, attendance cards, teacher grade books, student sign-in sheets, and OJT timecards signed by the employer.

*NOTE*: FTE Eligibility (ZSDBD098) \* will determine which students do not meet the above requirements and place a Code of "N" on the A08 Terms panel under FTE. FTE-2, FTE-3.

\*This program runs for Surveys 2 and 3 only starting on survey week of the reporting survey.

# The FTE Survey "Audit Box"

The term "box" refers to any means used to organize the materials from each FTE survey. Most reports can be converted to PDF and saved to a CD or flash drive. Examples:

- ■All printouts, such as the FTE-1 report (TS7006) listing students by course and the FTE reported for each survey, should be filed in such a way that individual student records can be traced and cross-referenced when errors are reported by the State and corrections are needed.
- All State and Local FTE reports, such as Fundable/Non-Fundable FTE, error reports (Edit, Validation, Exception and Batch update), TERMS External Reporting Series, FTE Summaries, etc., should be filed in chronological order thus keeping each survey separate from each other. New reports should be cross-referenced to the corrections that were made from previous reports to aid in making additional corrections. *A chronological trail of all corrections should be maintained.*

■ Master Teacher Schedule in place during the FTE survey week.

- Class lists for each teacher reflecting the students in that class as of the last day of the FTE survey week (date certain).
- Schedules and entry and withdrawal records for Hospital/Homebound students.
- □Student sign-in sheets.
- □ Special Program eligibility data reports and rosters for ESE and ELL students. □FTE Eligibility ZSDBD098

□DWH School Reports ATT1004 – Average Daily Attendance for the 11-day count down period, signed by Principal.

Chapter 6A-1.04513 of the Florida Administrative Code states that these records shall be maintained in auditable condition, shall be made available to the Department of Education for auditing, and shall be kept for a period of three (3) years or until the completion of an audit by the state audit agency, whichever period is longer.

Helpful Hint: Wait until the final collection of FTE data from TERMS before generating school reports. The final pull from TERMS represents the data that will be submitted to the state for FTE purposes.



Vaccine Status, Date is a ten-character field which presents information about each of the vaccines required for children. For most cases, the first character tells the vaccine type, the second denotes the dose in the series and the remaining eight characters represent the date the dose in a series was administered. (Also see Immunization Status.)

### **Special Cases**

There are also two special cases which will indicate that dates are not required for some individuals because: 1) they have a medical or religious exemption, or

#### Examples and conversion procedures:

### For students in the district's automated system prior to 7/1/91:

For students with an Immunization Status of 1 (permanent immunization certificate), the date of the immunization would default to the last dose in the series, i.e., DTP 2031573 would be A519730315, except the first dose of MMR, MR or Measles should be coded as the first dose in the series.

Students with an Immunization Status of 2 (temporary medical certificate requiring follow-up), presenting a 680A (Permanent Immunization Certificate), should be treated as new enrollees and all dates entered in the system.

For students with an Immunization Status of 3 (permanent medical exemption), for one vaccine only, the date of the other immunizations would default to the last dose in the series, i.e., polio 4041076 would be D419760410.

Students with an Immunization Status of 0 presenting evidence of immunizations should be treated as new enrollees.

### 2. Examples:

A student presents a valid HRS 680C Permanent Medical Exemption Certificate which indicates that he must not be vaccinated for medical reasons.

This student would be coded with an Immunization Status of 3 and Vaccine Status, Date would be **90EXEMP7\_\_**.

A student presented a valid PD 137 form at the time of initial entry into a Florida school. No vaccination dates were required.

This student would be coded with an Immunization Status of 1 and Vaccine Status, Date would be 80999999999

### APPENDIX EE VACCINE STATUS AND DATE

A student presents a valid DH or HRS 680A which indicates that he was immunized for MR and mumps on 04/30/91 and MMR given on 05/30/91.

The student would be coded with an Immunization Status of 1 and would have four vaccine status dates entered: G119910430, I119910430, H119910430 and F219910530.

A student presents a valid DH or HRS 680A which indicates that he was immunized for MMR on 01/01/89.

The student would be coded as F119890101.

A student with a valid DH or HRS 680A form submits a valid physician's note explaining that he had measles on 01/01/90.

The student would be coded with an immunization status of 1 and would have a vaccine status (for the measles dose) of **G1EXEMPT**.

### New seventh grade requirements – 1997-98

Effective with the 1997-98 school year students entering or attending 7th grade are required to show proof of completing the hepatitis B vaccination series, a second MMR and a tetanus-diphtheria booster.

A student presenting a valid 680A Certificate of Immunization which indicates that he/she was immunized for hepatitis B, first dose on 11/23/96, second dose on 12/23/96 and third dose on 3/23/97, or students 11-15 years of age presenting a valid 680A-2 which indicates that he/she was immunized with a two dose series, first dose on 11/23/96 and second dose on 3/23/97, a second MMR administered on 11/23/96 and a tetanus-diphtheria booster administered on 11/23/96 would be coded with an immunization status of 8 and would have five vaccine status dates entered: J119961123, J219961123, J219961123 and C119961123
