## EDUCATOR

### **Awareness & Involvement** (22 points max)

- ☞ Fosters awareness of the natural and built environments
- ☞ Promotes an understanding of concepts, issues, feelings, values, attitudes and perceptions at the heart of environmental issues
- ☞ Advocates civic responsibility, encouraging learners to use their knowledge, personal skills, and assessments of issues as a basis for problem-solving and action
- ☞ Forges relationships between the environment, school and community
- ☞ Utilizes the outdoors and/or alternative sites in his/her environmental stewardship practices
- ☞ Employs alternative methods for teaching tools
- ☞ High school: Team competes at the regional Envirothon competition

### **Current Professional Development** (22 points max)

- ☞ Attends professional development opportunities such as workshops and conferences
- ☞ Arranges for additional teaching and learning development
- ☞ Seeks additional training in environmental education and issues
- ☞ Collaborates with other educators

### **Instructional Soundness/Creativity** (22 points max)

- ☞ Utilizes instructional techniques that create an effective learning environment
- ☞ Uses community resources
- ☞ Motivates connections to real-life
- ☞ Emphasizes the use of techniques for different learning styles
- ☞ Develops interdisciplinary instruction, learner centered instruction, and a variety of assessment strategies
- ☞ Integrates current environmental issues into learning opportunities and activities

### **Skill Building** (22 points max)

- ☞ Teaches lifelong skills that enable students to prevent and address environmental issues
- ☞ Fosters critical thinking and problem-solving activities, programs, and experiments
- ☞ Motivates students to seek environment-related courses and fields in higher education and/or careers

### **Attachments** (12 points) – documentation and photos (should be high quality images)

- ☞ Provides letter(s) of recommendation(s), other documentation to support application (3 points)
- ☞ Provides at least one high quality image of just the nominee (2 points)
- ☞ Provides pictures and documentation to support the narratives (7 points)

## HOW TO APPLY:

There are 2 ways to send in your application (you can use both or just the Canvas application):

1) Via **ArcGIS Survey123 app** you can access through your phone or your computer. You can take pictures (real-time) and send them towards your application. Make sure that the info you add into the ArcGIS form includes what's in the rubric (previous page).

If it asks you for your organization's name, enter browardschools. Then click the Broward Schools blue bar and login using your P# and password.

2) Via **Canvas** (<https://bit.ly/2024P3Applications>). We'll create an application page for your nominee under Opened Applications or Collaborations. Send an email to [browardstem@browardschools.com](mailto:browardstem@browardschools.com) with the following information:

1. Your name and email address (and the names and email addresses of any collaborators) – must be @browardschools.com email address
2. Nominee's name(s) or school name
3. School category (1-5 or all) or Stewardship category (educators, students, non-instructional or custodial staff).

Once we receive your info for the Canvas page, look under the Opened Applications or Collaborations link (left side of Canvas) to see your nominee's name (school or stewardship category). You and your collaborators should be able to access the page(s).

What's the difference between the two ways?

ArcGIS Survey123 app - You can take pictures using your phone or tablet and directly send them to support your application. However, your collaborators have to send in pictures via their own account. The Canvas application has the full requirements.

Canvas application – you can have collaborators working on the same application but you have to upload the pictures. This has the full application template.
