Juniors and Seniors who plan on playing NCAA Division I or II sports in college must register with the <u>NCAA Eligibility Center</u>. This should be done during the student-athlete's junior year before taking the ACT or SAT for the first time. *If you are a Senior and have not done this yet, register today!*

To send ACT/SAT scores to the NCAA, use the code 9999 when you register for the test.

Students should also know which Cypress Bay HS courses have been approved by the NCAA. <u>Review the course list here</u>. Type 101842 for our school code and hit "Enter". You will be able to look up your courses by subject area.
