Things to do before the program starts

- 1. Attend the MANDATORY <u>Nursing Orientation (date TBA)</u>. Student and Parent/guardian are required to attend
- 2. Read through the entire program information packet
- 3. See the physician and complete the physical and immunization form. ***The immunization form MUST be signed AND stamped in EACH box.
- ***** There are <u>no exceptions</u>. ALL items are required by the health science programs and must be completed for the clinical rotation. This includes all immunizations to be up to date.
- ***McFatter does not determine the mandatory requirements that are established by the clinical facility. Students are required to attend clinical to complete the nursing program.
- 3a. Make sure to receive TWO PPD tests. This means you must receive the first test.....return 48-72 hours to have it read.....Then receive a second test......return 48-72 hours to have it read
 - ***This test must be done annually and is required by the clinical sites...
 - ***Suggestion: WAIT to receive the test closer to just before the program starts, in December/January, this way you may only need it once while in the program. ***
- ***Once all completed, keep the immunization and physical form. This will be uploaded into the clinical rotation system once the program starts. ***AIM TO HAVE THE PHYSICAL/IMMUNIZATION FORMS COMPLETED BY THANKSGIVING BREAK.

The flu shot is required during flu season.... This is after the start of the program. (further information will be provided after the program starts)

- 4. Read, agree, and sign the Health Science Clinical Requirements Acknowledgement form and return the form. (done at orientation)
- 5. Return the email contact form. (done at orientation)
- 6. Attend an informational session and sign up for the drug screen and fingerprinting (date TBA closer to October)
- 7. Attend the question-and-answer session and pick up first set of books. This is set up by the PN teacher just before the program starts. (usually late November/ early December)
