We are excited that you are considering Bayside Clubs at Manatee Bay. Bayside Clubs is an Extended Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP) . Bayside Clubs provide students with the following:

- Participation in multiple forms of co-curricular activities involving common interests of club members.

Days and Times of Club Meetings

The Winter Session of Bayside Clubs begins on Monday, December 9th, 2019 and ends on Monday, March 2nd. Monday and Thursday clubs meet from 2:00 – 3:30p.m. The Drama Club meets on Fridays beginning October 11th. Drama ends at 4:30pm.

Cost

Eight week club sessions are \$140 per child. There is a 10% discount for additional sibling, SBBC employees and children that attend MBE 2.0. Payment is made online through the eStore on the day of registration. CHECKS AND CASH ARE NOT ACCEPTED.

Registration

Parents MUST register on campus at Manatee Bay on the assigned days. Staff is available to help with the registration process and online payments through the eStore. Please bring your username and password for the eStore.

Arrival/Dismissal

Students are dismissed from class to the cafeteria on their club days. MBE 2.0 students must go to aftercare and will be sent to clubs after attendance. For all other students Bayside Clubs begin at 2:00p.m. Mrs. Vital and other teachers will stay with the children until the club sponsor arrives at 2:30p.m.

Each club will have a check-in and check-out notebook. Upon the students' arrival, the teachers will take attendance and mark the students absent or present on the attendance sheets. **If your child will be absent from clubs email Jaime.Vital@browardschools.com and you child's teacher(s)**. Students will be released only to adults listed on the student's *Bayside Clubs Registration Form*, this is the information entered through PDMS. Students, who are not picked up at the end of club meeting sessions- 3:30p.m., must be picked up in Mrs. Vital's classroom. Parents will be charged an additional \$15 fee if this occurs. It is a \$15 fee for each 15 minute interval.

Afterschool Programs

Please note that Bayside Clubs are separate from MBE 2.0. Both programs have separate fees. Parents who are not able to pick up their students from clubs by 3:30p.m. may pay for their child to attend MBE 2.0. MBE 2.0 is available daily until 6:00p.m.
