PURPOSE OF SUMMER EXPERIENCE: ELEMENTARY

Summer Experience is to provide remediation to student one or more grade levels behind in ELA and/or Math

This is not traditional Summer School

Summer Experience is **NOT FOR PROMOTION** to the next grade level

ESY will be occurring simultaneously as normal

The 3rd Grade Academy will be occurring simultaneously, and those students may be considered for promotion

Important Information

Promotion – 3rd Grade Reading Academy

- Third grade students who were not promoted in June 2022 will have an additional opportunity to be promoted at the end of Third Grade Summer Reading Academy.
- The SAT-10 will be used for promotion for Third Grade Summer Reading Academy. The assessment will be administered Tuesday, July 26, 2022, with a make-up day on Wednesday, July 27, 2022. Students must score in the 45th percentile or higher on the SAT-10 to be promoted to fourth grade.
- Results on whether students will be promoted or not will be available in Virtual Counselor to the parent(s)/guardian(s) of tested students.

What is the curriculum for ESY?

- Students in ESY will be working on individual goals through the Unique Curriculum. Teachers will meet determine individual the needs and materials based on targeted and individual skills/needs. ESE Specialists will identify material needs specific to the students. The ESY folder provided by the sending school will have student specific information, such as ID, picture schedule, and other student-specific, helpful information. There has also been an elementary and secondary ESY canvas course for instructional staff to utilize for additional resources.

Summer Experience Goals Elementary Model

Focus:

- Academic recovery in literacy and mathematics, incorporating cross-curricular content in the areas of art, music, debate and STEM.
- Science and social studies will be embedded throughout the literacy block.
- Lessons have been designed to provide students with opportunities to transfer their learning and apply to real-world applications.
- *SEL and Mindfulness will be embedded throughout the day.*

Targeted Acceleration: Focusing on standards from the grade level the student just completed and the aligned standards for the next grade level
