Safety and security are our top priorities. Please make sure to remember the following safety procedures:

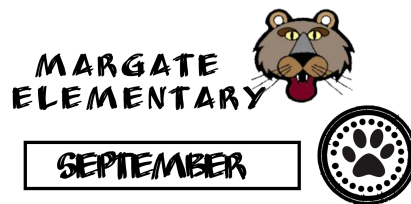
- All visitors must report to the front office.

Overview

Margate Elementary was identified as a Title One School for the 2022-2023 school year, based on our number of eligible free and reduced lunch students. Schools with 50% or more of the student population receiving free or reduced priced meals meet Title I eligibility. Title I is a federally funded program for economically disadvantaged children who reside in school attendance areas with a high concentration of children from low income families. Since a high incidence of poverty in a school has a direct correlation with low academic achievement Title I funds are used to provide supplementary instruction to raise the achievement of students who are failing to meet the challenge state standards. Title I funded personnel are instructional or support staff that directly contribute to the education of children and parents.

The purpose of Title I is to support school efforts to ensure that all children meet challenging academic standards and have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education. This purpose can be accomplished by providing additional resources for high poverty schools to enhance educational opportunities for disadvantaged students. Title I funds must be used in addition to District and State funds. All of the services students would receive in the absence of Title I must be in place before Title I funds are used. Title I funds may be used to benefit all of the students in a school-wide project. All Title I schools are required to spend no less than 1% of their Title I allocation on parental involvement training activities.

The Title I program for parents is designed to: 1. Inform parents about Title I regulations. 2. Provide literacy training. 3. Offer parents training in schools and the community on ways. 4. Encourage active participation in their children's schools and education.

A Parent Compact (which is an agreement by staff, parents, and students to share the responsibility for improved student academics and then a means to build a partnership that will help student's achieve the State's high standards) was sent home with all of the students in their first day packet. We are asking that you please read over the document, sign and return it back to school with your child to give to his/her teacher. More information will be forthcoming regarding parent trainings we have scheduled.

Visión general

La Primaria Margate fue identificada como una escuela de Título Uno para el año escolar 2020-2021, en base a nuestra cantidad de estudiantes elegibles con almuerzo gratis o reducido. Las escuelas con 50% o más de la población estudiantil que reciben comidas gratis o a precio reducido cumplen con la elegibilidad del Título I.

El Título I es un programa financiado con fondos federales para niños en desventaja económica que residen en áreas de asistencia escolar con una alta concentración de niños de familias de bajos ingresos. Dado que una alta incidencia de pobreza en una escuela tiene una correlación directa con el bajo rendimiento académico de los estudiantes, los fondos del Título I se utilizan para proporcionar instrucción complementaria para elevar el rendimiento de los estudiantes que no cumplen con los estándares estatales desafiante. El personal financiado por el Título I es personal docente o de apoyo que contribuye directamente a la educación de los niños y los padres.

El propósito del Título I es apoyar los esfuerzos de la escuela para garantizar que todos los niños cumplan con los estándares académicos desafiantes y tengan una oportunidad justa, igualdad y significativa de obtener una educación de alta calidad. Este propósito se puede lograr proporcionando recursos adicionales para las escuelas de alta pobreza para mejorar las oportunidades educativas para los estudiantes desfavorecidos. Los fondos del Título I deben usarse además de los fondos del Distrito y del Estado. Todos los servicios que los estudiantes recibirían en ausencia del Título I deben estar vigentes antes de que se utilicen los fondos del Título I.

Los fondos del Título I pueden usarse para beneficiar a todos los estudiantes en un proyecto escolar. Todas las escuelas de Título I deben gastar no menos del 1% de su asignación de Título I en actividades de capacitación para la participación de los padres.

El programa de Título I para padres está diseñado para: 1. Informar a los padres sobre las regulaciones de Título I. 2. Brindar capacitación en alfabetización. 3. Ofrecer a los padres capacitación en las escuelas y la comunidad sobre las formas. 4. Fomentar la participación activa en las escuelas y la educación de sus hijos.

Se envió a casa un Acuerdo de Padres (que es un acuerdo entre el personal, los padres y los estudiantes para compartir la responsabilidad de mejorar los estudios académicos de los estudiantes y luego un medio para construir una asociación que ayudará a los estudiantes a lograr los altos estándares del estado) con todos los estudiantes en su paquete del primer día. Le pedimos que lea el documento, lo firme y lo devuelva a la escuela con su hijo para dárselo a su maestro.

Próximamente habrá más información sobre las capacitaciones para padres que hemos programado.
