#### School Safety & Security



Dear Parents,

With the intention of providing a safe and secure campus C. Robert Markham Elementary is being provided a **full-time School Resource Officer** to support our Safe Team Plan. This person will always operate with the sole purpose of maintaining a safe and secure building.

The addition of this staff will allow our campus to increase perimeter security by **keeping all gates locked during the day,** unless an open entry way is monitored by a member of the security team. Signs will be posted on or near the entry gates, with the front office number so that a member of the Safe Team can immediately provide access to incoming visitors.

Please note that this will mean that car pickup/drop off areas will be strictly enforced, such as preventing cars from dropping students in the bus area. As we continue to make the safety of our children the priority your support is greatly appreciated!

1) Parents must apply every year for status renewal online.

2) Returning students who were "Free" last year, will be able to continue eating free in the New Year until 09/28/18.

3) By that date, if the Parent has not applied for status renewal - the student's status will revert to "full pay" and the student will be charged \$2 per meal.

### Student Dress Code- We Are a Mandatory Uniform School

Markham is a mandatory uniform school, and this will be enforced this year to maintain a **safe and secure environment** where all students are easily accounted for and recognized. Uniform tops must be White, Hunter Green, or Orange Polo Shirts (shirts with a collar) and Uniform bottoms must be Hunter Green or Khaki pants or shorts, skorts, skirts or jumpers.

No flip flops, slides or sandals will be allowed. Shoes must be closed and cover the heels and toes. \*Carlyn's Uniform and Walmart are good places to purchase uniforms.\*

In addition, all students and staff will wear ID badges at all times to enhance the daily security of the campus. Students will be provided ID badges that must always be warn while on campus. Teachers will store badges in the classroom for safe-keeping at the end of each day.
