▶Unit 3: **Daily Activities**: Describe daily activities, Likes and dislikes, Talk about where people are from, Ask yes and no information questions, Accept or turn down invitations, Express approval, regret, or surprise

► Unit 4: **People and Possessions**: Describe yourself and others, Describe your room, Talk about possessions, Talk about everyday objects

► Unit 5: City Life: Describe your city, Ask and give directions, Plan activities in town, Describe inside and outside of your home, Describe your family

► Unit 6: **Buying Clothes**: Discuss shopping plans, Buying clothes, Ask for help, Decide what to choose, Compare items, Talk about what you need and what you like, Give advice
