Course Schedule

- ▶ **Review:** **Review of Basic Material:** Review numbers, Tell date and time, Describe the weather, Describe things you own, Talk about daily activities, Compare likes and dislikes, Ask and answer questions
- ▶ **Unit 1:** **Describing oneself:** Giving basic information about oneself, Talk about professions, Describe friends and other people, describe one's feelings and needs
- ▶ **Unit 2:** **Talking about the past:** Talk about weekend plans, Describe leisure activities, Plan a visit to the country side
- ▶ **Unit 3:** **Defining Quantities:** Talk about favorite foods and beverages, Order in a French café or restaurant, Shop for food in a French market, Express what you want to do, what you can do, and what you must do
- ▶ **Unit 4:** **Entertainment and Leisure:** Describe and discuss various forms of entertainment, Discuss the types of movies you like, Talk about your favorite stars, Extend, accept, and turn down invitations, Describe relations with other people, Ask other for assistance, Read and write about daily events
- ▶ **Unit 5:** **Sports, health:** Name and describe favorite sports, Talk about daily activities and personal care, Identifying various parts of the body, Describe your daily routine, Describe common pains and illnesses
- ▶ **Unit 6:** **Talking about the past:** Talk about where you live, Describe your house, its rooms and its furnishings, Talk about the past, Describe the background of a past event, Talk about what you used to do on a regular basis
