Cambridge AICE Diploma Curriculum

The Cambridge AICE Diploma is made up of individual Cambridge International AS & A Levels, which have widespread international standing as educational qualifications.

Core

To achieve the Diploma, all learners will need to study and pass *Cambridge International AS Level Global Perspectives & Research* core class.

Subjects

Group 1: Mathematics and Sciences

Group 2: Languages

Group 3: Arts and Humanities

Group 4: Interdisciplinary subjects (optional)

Learners must achieve at least one credit (take the class and pass the exam) from each of Groups 1, 2 and 3. A maximum of two credits can count from Group 4, which is optional.

AICE Diploma and Bright Futures:

Students who earn an AICE diploma, based on AICE exams taken prior to high school graduation, complete the 100 hours of community service requirement, and submit their Florida Financial Aid Applications will earn the Florida Academic Scholars award (full Bright Futures scholarship).
