The Miami Herald/El Nuevo Herald's Silver Knight Awards is one of the nation's most highly regarded student awards programs. The purpose of the Silver Knight Awards program is to recognize outstanding students who have not only maintained good grades but have also unselfishly applied their special knowledge and talents to contribute significant service to their school and community. If you feel you have what it takes to become a Silver Knight, you must apply through your school's Silver Knight Coordinator.

## Entry Form Instructions:

1. Complete this entry form in its entirety. If you have any questions on how to complete this entry form, visit the Silver Knight website or make an appointment to see your school's Silver Knight Coordinator. The sections noted with Points Earned are for judges to complete during the application process – please do not write in these areas.
2. As a part of the competition process, you will need to appear in person for an interview with the Silver Knight judges on the specified day. Missing this interview will invalidate your application.
3. Answer all questions using only the space provided. List the most important achievements and service contributions; a short summary of top achievements is often better than a long list of lesser ones. You are allowed up to 12 pages of support documents (i.e., letters, awards, new clippings, photographs) that can be used to explain achievements and service.
4. The Entry Form must be typewritten. A letter-quality printout from a word processor may be pasted into the appropriate spaces. The minimum acceptable font size is 12.
5. Submit five copies of the Entry Form – the typed original plus four photocopies. Attach to each of these Entry Forms a photocopied set of the support documents. Use a paperclip to attach a 2x3 inches head-and-shoulders original color photo to the original Entry Form before photocopying. Your name, school and category must be printed on the back of the photo.
6. Nominees in the General Scholarship category (other category Nominees are excluded from this requirement) must also include five official unsealed copies of a complete high school transcript, including class rank and test scores such as SAT, ACT and Advanced Placement exams. Later, as updated transcript with first semester grades for the 12th grade can be given to judges at the interview. All Nominees are encouraged to list, under achievements, any significant test scores.
7. Community service should be documented wherever feasible. Do not submit audio or videocassettes. Do not submit your actual award certificates: instead make copies. Art nominees and New Media nominees are encouraged to bring portfolios to the interview. If you decide to bring portfolios of your work, please remember that the interview with the judges is approximately 10-minutes in length, therefore we recommend you using only 3-5 minutes of that time to show your work.
8. All photographs submitted with your application, including your program photograph and all community service photos will become the property of The Miami Herald and will not be returned. These photos may also be used for publication purposes.
9. Please ensure that your answers are true and accurate. Any applications that are found to contain false information will be disqualified and you will be barred from participating in the Silver Knight Awards competition.
