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CCHS CLASS OF 2019 PROM REGULATIONS

In an effort to assist you in purchasing proper Prom attire in a timely manner and to prevent you from purchasing clothing that will not be permitted, be advised that the dress code for Prom is Formal Attire that meets the following restrictions:

Acceptable for Females: one-piece dresses that show no part of the midsection (front or sides) or any private parts. All skirt slits **must end no higher than mid-thigh**.

Acceptable for Males: a tuxedo/suit. Young men may NOT remove any clothing other than their jackets in the event they become overheated.

Tickets may be revoked at the discretion of CCHS administration.

Administration reserves the right to deny access to the prom if dress is revealing, suggestive or indecent.

Boys must keep their shirt on at all times.
