

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1. Is school in person or via Teams eLearning this year? All students will be attending physically in person.
2. Will instruction be via Teams or in person? All students will be learning in person.
3. Will I be able to walk/escort my child to class? Only Pre-K, Kinder, and ESE Specialized program students may be escorted on the first day of school (Aug. 18, 2021). All students will walk independently to class after that.
4. Does my child have to wear a mask in school? Yes, all students, parents, staff, and visitors are required to wear facial covering as outlined in Policy 2170.
5. Can I sign a waiver (like the uniform waiver) for my child not to wear a mask? No. Please refer to Policy 2170- Section B i. Students with Approval: A face covering shall not be required for a student if the student's IEP or 504 team, after receiving a certification form a health care provider that the student has a medical, physical, or psychological contraindication that prevents the person from being able to safely wear an approved face covering, authorizes the student to remove her/his face covering during an activity provided that the student maintains physical distancing (six feet minimum) from other persons when not wearing a face covering. Face shields should be considered when granting an accommodation for not wearing an approved face covering.
6. Will the school supply my child with their daily face covering? No. All students, visitors, and vendors must supply and wear their own face coverings while at or inside a school district campus/facility or inside a school district vehicle.
7. What time does my child need to be at school? Children can be dropped between 7:30-8:00 am. Students should be seated and ready to learn at 8:00. Instruction starts promptly at 8:00 am.
8. Who can assist me if my child starts crying the first day of school? We have staff members throughout that help as well as a School Counselor on site.
9. Are parents able to volunteer at the school this year? Volunteers are able to come and help in the school. All volunteers must follow and adhere to

safety and health protocols and complete an online application at:
