Jumpstart to Read Is Coming!








FRONT OFFICE PROCEDURES

Please wait patiently to be buzzed into the office. If you are visiting the campus, you will be checked in with your ID through our Raptor System and issued a visitor's pass to wear. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS 🦣



Students should not arrive to school before 7:30 AM. Doing so poses a safety risk, as there is no supervision prior to 7:30 AM. Breakfast is served beginning at 7:30 AM and students eating breakfast must be in line by 7:45 AM, unless they are on a late bus. All students are expected to be in their grade level hallway until the first bell at 7:50 AM. While sitting in the hallway, all students are expected to have a book for reading. Once in their grade level hallway, students will not be allowed to leave the hallway for any reason. Students are expected to be in their classroom, ready to learn by 7:50 AM.

Dismissal Procedures:

We dismiss at 2:00 PM for all students. Parents wishing to sign their student out early must do so before 1:30 PM (according to Board Policy 5.5) unless it is an emergency (administrative approval will be required).
