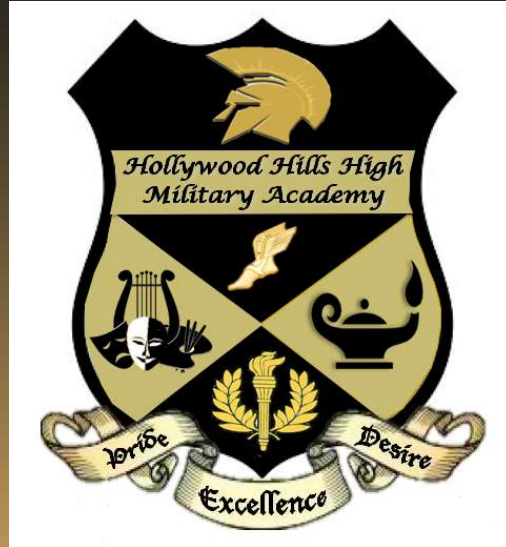


# Entrepreneur and Leadership Business Academy

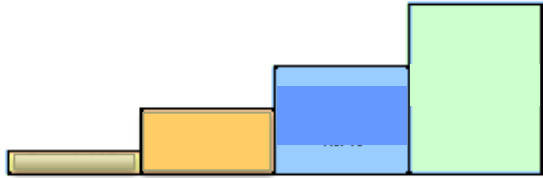

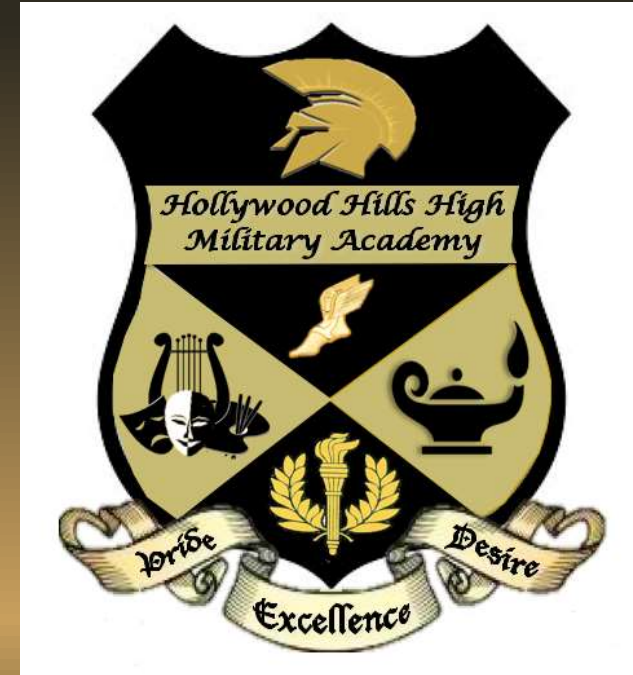
