

## 2018 -2019 MORROW STUDENT AWARDS CRITERIA

### Principal's "Hall of Fame" Award for Educational Excellence -Dr. Crowle- Principal

This **award** recognizes academic success in the classroom. To be eligible, students must meet requirements, including grade point average of **4s** in every subject ('1s' in Grades k -2), outstanding citizen and proficient in Math and Reading, Proficient in both Reading and Math iReady Diagnostics. Each teacher selects candidates and the final selection is made by the Principal.

### Patriot Award: Mr. Brightman- Assistant Principal

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### 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Quarterly Awards Criteria

- **Citizenship Award**
  - “1” in Respects Authority
  - “1” in Shows Respects for Property and Rights of Others
  - “1’s or 2’s” in all other Social Growth indicators
  
  - Grade Point Average (GPA)- Students earn 4 points for an A, 3 points for a B, 2 points for a C, 1 point for a D, 0 points for an F. Points are added based on student’s grades and divided by 5 (5 subject areas). The total is the student’s GPA and students will receive the following award based on their GPA:
- **Gold Award**: 4.0 GPA and “1’s or 2’s” in Social Growth and Study Skills Indicators
- **Silver Award**: 3.5-3.9 GPA and “1’s or 2’s” in Social Growth and Study Skills Indicators
- **Bronze Award**: 3.0-3.4 GPA and “1’s or 2’s” in Social Growth Indicators
  
- **Perfect Attendance Award**: No absences and no more than one tardy per quarter
  
- **Most Improved Award (4<sup>th</sup> quarter only)**- Grades increased (F’s, D’s, C’s to A’s and B’s) from beginning of the year and/or behavior improved (3’s to 2’s and 1’s)
  
- **Jean Skulina Scholarship Award** (5<sup>th</sup> grade only): Each 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Teacher will nominate a boy and a girl from their class who has “1” in Shows Effort for all four quarters on their Report Card and has less than three absences for the year. One boy and one girl will be selected from the total students nominated to receive the Scholarship.

### Read Across Broward Criteria (End of Year)

This award recognizes students who read independently within the year.

Students may log into Beanstack (SSO) to document books read or complete the traditional paper form.

The criteria is as follows: **Level 1 (K-2)** Picture book readers

Participation Award (25-49 books)

Silver Award (50-74 books)

Gold Award (75-99 books)

Superintendent's Honor Roll (100 or more books, including 5 awards)

**Level 2 (3<sup>rd</sup> -5<sup>th</sup>)** Chapter book readers

Participation Award (10-25 books)

Silver Award (26-34 books)

Gold Award (35-49 books)

## 2018 -2019 MORROW STUDENT AWARDS CRITERIA

### MyOn Awards

- **Quarterly Morrow myOn Mover Award-**

This award recognizes student who have moved their Reading Lexile level by 50 points or more over the course of the quarter while maintaining a 70 % or higher quiz average. Student must log on at least once a week.

- **End of year Morrow myOn Mover Award**

This award recognizes the top, (defined by the most Lexile growth) 3 students at each grade level that have read at least 25 books over the course of the year and maintained a 70 % or higher quiz average

### Mathematics Award Criteria:

#### Mathletes Award: BCCTM Math Competition

This award is given to 10 students selected to represent Morrow Elementary at the Annual BCCTM Math Competition. This **trophy** will be given to represent the brightest mathematicians in Grade 4 and Grade 5. A school competition will be conducted to determine eligibility. Students and teachers will also receive a Morrow Elementary T-Shirt and certificate.

- Students must place in the top ten highest scores on the inhouse placement competition test
- Students must be a member of the Morrow Math Club to compete
- Student overall academic performance in all subjects must be 85%
- Students must have a nomination letter signed by teachers
- Parent consent letter signed

### Athlete of the Quarter Award (PE)

- Sportsmanship (respect teachers and classmates)
- Commitment (toward daily activities and improvement)
- Honesty (playing by rules and character)
- Positive attitude and enthusiasm for during each PE activity (encouraging classmates and trying their hardest)
- Teamwork
- Focus and Discipline
- Perseverance (overcoming challenges)
