How to Provide Proof of Address

Submit current proofs of residence from the table below, based upon your type of residence

If you OWN or RENT your residence: (option 1)

• Submit one document from both Columns A and B

If you SHARE the housing of another person who owns/rents the home: (option 2)

- Both the registering parent and owner/renter of the residence complete a notarized Affidavit of Shared Residence Form
- The owner/renter of the residence must submit one document from both Columns A and B and
- The registering parent must submit two documents from Column B.

If you answer "yes" to certain residency questions on the Student Registration Form, you may qualify for the HOMELESS Education Program (HEP) under the McKinney-Vent Act.
