Broward County Public Schools Superintendent Robert W. Runcie provided remarks during Tuesday's, August 4, Special School Board Meeting that included his continued recommendation that **all students, including students with special needs, begin the 2020/21 school year through eLearning.** The District is exploring the development of a **voluntary pilot program** for face-to-face instruction for students with special needs if **we can find staff and families of students with disabilities who are willing to participate.**
