VPK

Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) is available to children that will be 4 years old by **September 1, 2025**. BCPS offers full and half school day options. **Teachers** have a Bachelor's Degree or higher and Florida Teaching Certificate specializing in Early Childhood Education. Some schools offer programs for 3-year-old children.
