Important Information

- Please note: In order to maintain a safe and secure campus, ALL of the perimeter gates will be LOCKED during school hours.
- Every student is required to wear a student ID at ALL times. There are no exceptions. Student IDs will be provided by the school. Please note, when the fifth request for a badge is received, the student must purchase a new, permanent identification badge at a cost not to exceed \$5.00.
- All visitors on campus MUST have an ID. Please remember to bring your valid **ID** **EVERYTIME** you pick up your child. Under **NO** circumstances will ANYONE be allowed to pick up a child without proper ID.
- Supervision is provided on campus from 7:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.. There is NO supervision prior to 7:30 a.m.. Please **DO NOT** drop students off prior to 7:30 a.m..
- We are a uniform school. Every student is expected to be in a uniform every day.
 - Students' adherence to our uniform policy is important in helping us identify students on campus. For more information on approved colors and types of clothing, please refer to your child's first day packet.
 - Students not adhering to the school's uniform policy will receive progressive consequences.
- Arrival and Dismissal information.
 - ONLY PreK and Headstart students will be dismissed from the carloop starting at 1:45 P.M. daily.
 - K-5 Students will be dismissed starting at 2:00 P.M.
 - Please drop off and pick up students at designated drop off/pick up locations, either the South Car Loop, East Walkers Gate or West Walkers Gate. **DO NOT** drop students off at the front of the school. The front of the school is **NOT** a drop off or pick up location.

- **Car-line-** Students are dropped off in the car line on the South of school and enter the building through the back single point of entry into the cafeteria.
 - **Biker/Walker-** (East, or West Gate) Students walk up to the school along the designated sidewalk and enter through the West Walkers Gate or East Walkers Gate.
 - **Bus Rider-** Students arrive to school on a bus and proceed to breakfast or their classroom through the front door entry.
 - Dismissal- Please be advised the front parking lot is **NOT** a dismissal location
 - Any student who walks off campus **MUST** be dismissed as a walker from the East Walkers Gate or the West Walkers Gate.
 - Bus Riders and Van Riders will be dismissed from their classrooms to the bus area.
 - ASP students will be dismissed from the classrooms to their counselors.
- Dismissal Definitions:
 - **Car Riders:**
 - Leave the car line in a car.
 - No child will be permitted to walk off the car line and cross traffic.
 - **Walkers/Bike Riders** (*2 dismissal locations*):
 - **West Gate** -Walk off campus from the WEST exit and walk west from the school.
 - **East Gate**- Walk off campus from the EAST exit and walk from the school.
- Late Arrival and Early Dismissal
 - Students who arrive to school after 8:00 A. M. **MUST** come through the front office with a parent to receive a tardy pass.
 - A parent must sign out their student who requires an early dismissal **BEFORE 1:30 PM (11:30 AM on Early Release Days)**. No student will be signed out after 1:30 unless a doctors note is provided.
- Food and Nutrition
 - All students will receive FREE Breakfast and Lunch daily. Ice Cream sales are on Wednesday at a cost of \$0.65.
- Attendance
 - IF your child is absent from school, you **MUST** call the attendance line at 754-322-7402 within 48 hours to report the absence.
- After School Program
 - Our after-school program is held on site by ASP (After-School Provider). To register for this program, please call ASP at 954-695-7401.
- This year all Emergency Forms and Code of Conduct forms are available online. These forms are mandatory for each of our students and your assistance in completing these items is appreciated. The website is www.browardschools.com/bts. Please review ALL first day forms online and

sign the acknowledgment papers provided within your child's 1st day packets. If you need any assistance or would like to use a computer, please stop by the front office.
