- Monitor whole group and small group differentiated instruction in K through 5 uninterrupted 90 minutes reading block
- Ensure that all instructional in foundational reading skills is systematic and explicit and already instruction is evidence based.
- Carefully planned sequence of instruction is designed to build upon.
- Effective approach to make sure that the needs of students are being meet
- Teachers will continue to align data with the standards
- There are tools that are used to monitor student's success such as I-ready, BAS
- By using the intervention programs such as ESSER being used as intervention to close the achievement gap
