MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Bulldog Battalion Scholarship Application

- 1. This information provides guidance for the qualification of cadets to be authorized to apply for the South Broward High School Army JROTC Annual Scholarship
- 2. Cadets who are enrolled in the Army Junior ROTC Program at South Broward High School are eligible to earn South Broward High School Scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded to the top cadet(s) that represent the program, school, and community. These individuals truly will meet and define "Motivated young men and women being better citizens".
- 3. To be considered for the Scholarship each student must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Been in JROTC for a minimum of two years.
 - b. Served in a Leadership position at the Company or Battalion Level
 - c. Participated in two Co-Curricular seasons.
 - d. Have a 3.0 GPA or above in JROTC and at least a 2.5 unweighted GPA overall.
 - e. Have no in-school or out-of-school suspensions (ISS or OSS respectively).
 - f. Completed at least 150 community service hours.
 - g. Must be accepted to a college with intent to enroll.
 - h. Write a minimum of 500 word essay based on the following prompt:

"How your experiences in SBHS JROTC have prepared you for your future after high school"

- 4. Each application will be reviewed by the Senior Army Instructor, Army Instructor and a third party if the two do not agree on the approval of all scholarships. All personal information will be redacted during the meeting to avoid any perception of favoritism.
- 5. Scholarships will range between \$250-\$1000 based on annual fundraising and approved applicants. Applications will be available from Jan-March and presented during the annual awards ceremony. Scholarship funds will be delivered to the Cadets enrolled college not to the individual. All submissions must be sent to benjaminj.logsdon@browardschools.com no later than 24 March 2024.
