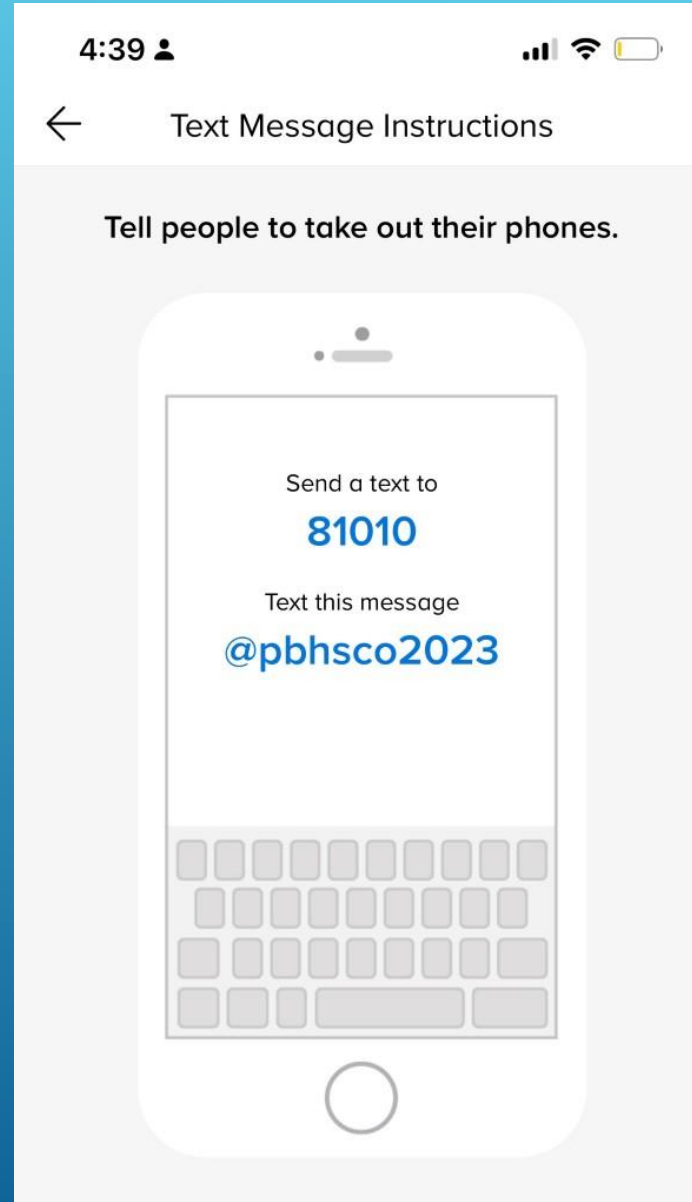

Senior Week FAQs



Q: Why does a senior have to attend class during senior finals week?

A: Each course has a required number of minutes needed to earn credit for graduation. Seniors need to attend class to meet the “minutes” requirement. Seniors will also need to attend classes from May 30- to June 1 and June 5. A schedule for that week will be posted on Canvas in the Class of 2023 page.

Q: Does a student exempting an exam need to report to class on the exempted day?

A: No, however you will need to either report to the holding room or sign out.

Q: How will a student know if their grade falls below a B average before the exam?

A: It is the student's responsibility to confirm their exemption status before the scheduled exam.

Q: Can a student with all A's and B's take all their exams?

A: Yes

Q: If a student completes the form to exempt the exam, can the student take the exam anyway?

A: Yes

Q: Can a student exempt the same class for both midterm and final exams?

A: Yes

FAQs



Q: Can Advanced Placement (AP) finals be exempted?

A: Yes

Q: Why is there a deadline to turn in the exam exemption form?

A: Teachers need to be notified of each student that is opting to exempt an exam.

Q: Is attendance at the graduation rehearsal following the senior breakfast on June 1 required?

A: Yes. Seniors are required to attend the graduation rehearsal to participate in the PBHS Commencement Ceremony on June 2.

Q: Do seniors with senior privilege need to use the *Late Arrival/Early Sign-out Form* to indicate that they will arrive late or leave early due to senior privilege?

A: No. Seniors should NOT complete the *Late Arrival/Early Sign-out Form* for the class periods you already arrive late or leave early.

Q: Can a senior complete the *Late Arrival/Early Sign-out Form* to arrive late and sign out early on the same day?

A: Yes. For example, if you are exempting the Block 5 exam and leaving early after the Block 6 exam, you can use the form to indicate your late arrival and early dismissal.

Q: How can I report a FULL DAY Absence for May 22 – June 5?

A: Please use the online reporting form found on our website under “Contact” under “Report an Absence”. Please DO NOT call in your absence.

Dear Graduating Senior and Parent/Guardian:

Graduation from high school is an important event in the lives of students, parents, and families. It is an opportunity to celebrate the educational accomplishments of students. The graduation ceremony is designed to provide memories and impressions that will last a lifetime. We need your assistance to ensure that your student's graduation ceremony is conducted in a dignified manner.

Your school's principal and staff have spent significant time planning and organizing the graduation ceremony. It is very important that all graduation participants and attendees conduct themselves in a polite and courteous fashion. The graduation ceremony is a dignified event and requires all attendees to be on their best behavior. To ensure that your school's graduation is conducted in a dignified fashion, we expect students and parents to adhere to the following principles of decorum and etiquette:

Parents and Guests

- Appropriate dress is recommended (e.g. business attire for the men, semi formal for the ladies).
- Personal use of cameras without flash and hand-held video cameras are permitted as long as one remains in their seat and respects the viewing rights of attendees. Flash photography and standup videoclipping are not permitted during the graduation ceremony. Your school may hire a professional photographer and video specialist for the ceremony. Contact the principal's office for information on the purchase of graduation pictures or graduation video.
- Follow the school principal's instructions for applause and recognition during the ceremony.
- Noisemakers, including air horns or whistles, are not permitted in the graduation venue and their use is strictly prohibited.
- The throwing of beach balls, balloons, or other related items are strictly prohibited during the graduation ceremony.
- The throwing of confetti is not permitted during the graduation ceremony.
- The graduation program will designate those individuals who are authorized to address the audience and graduates. No individual may speak to the audience without the specific permission and authorization of the school principal.

- Graduation ceremonies will be starting promptly; therefore, all parents and guests should arrive at the graduation venue prior to the start of the graduation ceremony. Late arrivals shall not be seated until the conclusion of the presentation of colors and the singing of the national anthem. Please recognize there are hundreds of guests attending graduation ceremonies, so make every effort to arrive early.

Student Graduates

- Students are reminded that their conduct and responsibility at graduation ceremonies and rehearsals shall follow the rules set forth in the Secondary Code of Student Conduct.
- Students shall follow the protocol procedures and schedule of events as established and reviewed in the graduation rehearsal.
- Graduation caps shall be worn at all times.
- Students should recognize the importance of the graduation ceremony and dress appropriately.
- The graduation program will designate those students who are authorized to address the graduates and class. No student may speak to the audience without the specific permission and authorization of the school principal.
- Noisemakers, including air horns or whistles, are not permitted in the graduation venue and their use is strictly prohibited.
- The throwing of beach balls, balloons, or other related items at the graduation ceremony are strictly prohibited.
- Throwing of confetti is not permitted during the graduation ceremony.



Tickets and Programs

- All guests, no matter the age, will need a ticket. Graduating seniors do not need a ticket. The single point of entry for guests is the northeast entrance to the stadium.
- Disabled seating will be on the gym floor with 1 other person. Contact Mr. Gordon ahead of time.
- Tickets for graduation will be issued during the required MANDATORY rehearsal on June 1st
- Programs will also be distributed during the rehearsal. It is the responsibility of the graduate to distribute the four tickets and programs.
- 1 extra tickets will be given to everyone who made a request using the online form

Attire

- No dresses longer than the graduation gown
 - Wear dark pants and dark shoes
 - Heels should be suitable to walk up stairs
 - No flowers, excessive jewelry, or accessories

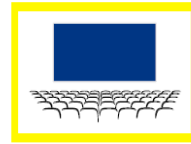

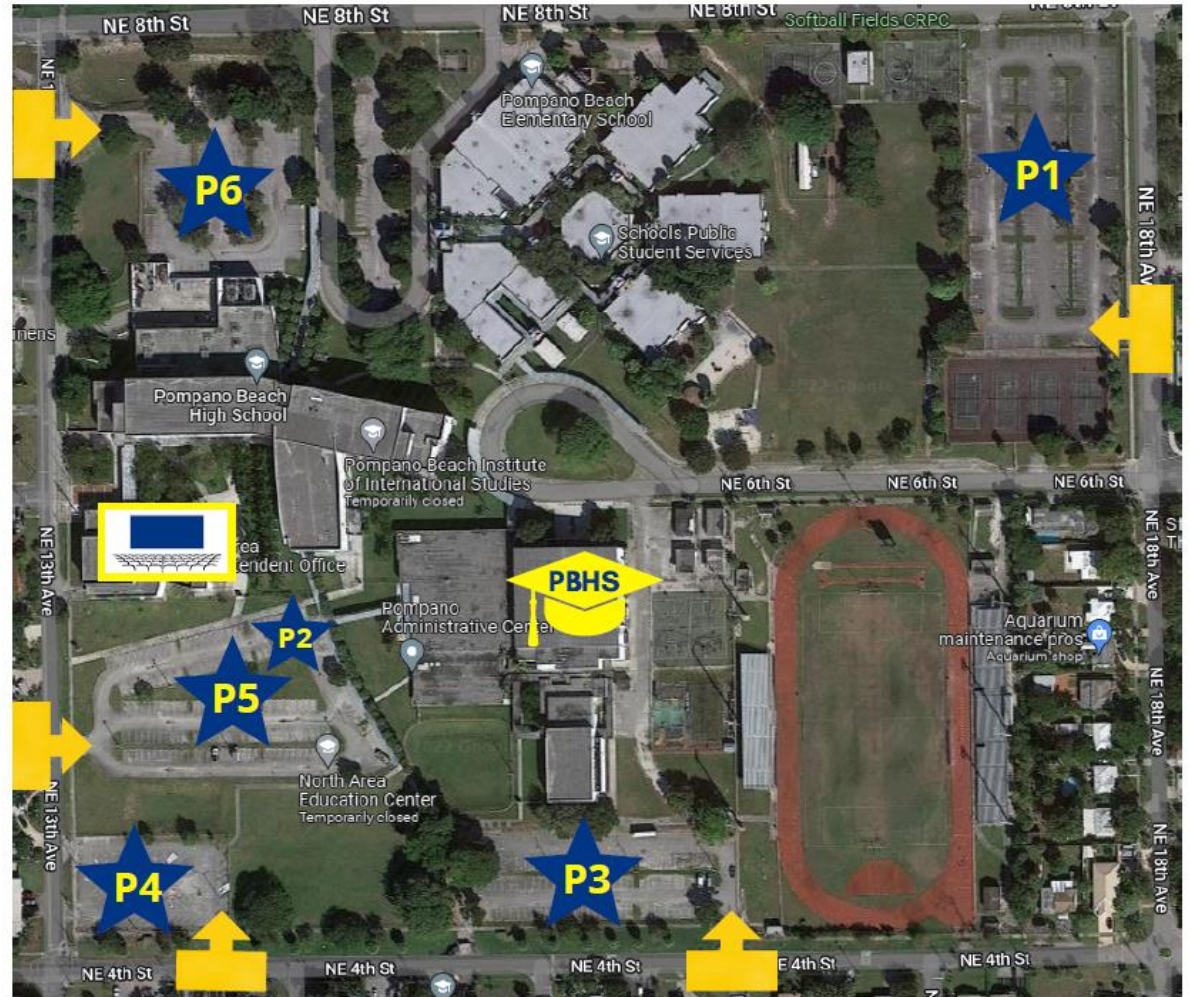
