What is the Cambridge Program?



The Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) is a rigorous, internationally recognized course of study for academically talented and motivated students. At the middle school level, it is called "Cambridge Secondary 1." This program, sponsored by the University of Cambridge in England, offers a unique middle school curriculum focused on global awareness.





Program Requirements – Academic



Students in the Cougar Path — Cambridge Academy must maintain a 3.0 GPA in core classes at the end of each grading period. Students who fall below a 3.0 in core classes will be placed on temporary academic probation. If the students' GPA remains below a 3.0 at the end of the year, he/she may be removed from the program for the following year.

Students must also maintain passing grades in all elective classes.





Program Requirements – Disciplinary



Students must exhibit and maintain acceptable conduct standards as set forth by the Broward County Code of Conduct and Glades Middle School. Failure to abide by these guidelines may result in removal from the program.

Students must attend school regularly. Excessive absences, tardiness, and/or checkouts may also result in removal from the program.
