### **A Day in the Life of E-Learning**

- **Our virtual school day starts at 8:30 A.M. Students will take 6 courses daily. Student schedules consist of four core classes [Math, Science, Language Arts, Social Studies] and up to two electives. The student day concludes at 2:55 P.M. Teacher work hours are from 8:30 A.M.- 4:00 P.M.**
- **Each class period is 55 minutes in length. 5 minutes of “passing time/brain breaks” are built in after each class period.**
- **Under our E-Learning Schedule, students and teachers will follow their schedule as if we were in a traditional setting. Students/Teachers will log in to their classes at the aforementioned times. Each period, teachers will engage in “live interaction” with students via Microsoft Teams + Canvas Integration.**
- **The use of Microsoft Teams will be utilized as the vehicle for providing live interaction. The use of Canvas will be utilized to facilitate announcements, submission of assignments and house course content. Teachers will orient students into the virtual routine during an “acclimation phase” where we will focus on building routines and relationships.**
