
## Is your child ready to start this coming school year with the skills needed to be a successful reader?

Broward County Schools is offering you a completely **FREE resource** to work one-on-one with your child over the summer to help them **build reading skills**! All that is required is a smartphone and **5 minutes of your child's time 2-3 times per week**! A trained district approved reading specialist who has been working with your child already, during the school year, will call on the smartphone number that you provide, at agreed upon times and dates. She will work individually with your child to help build reading skills. Your child will follow along with the specialist as they work on reading lessons. The specialist will also provide you with simple activities you can do at home to provide practice for your child.

It works with a free app that you download to your phone. The reading specialist will walk you through the simple setup. The specialist has the lessons on their laptop and your child sees the same screen on the phone. It looks like this:
