IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Late Items- Please make sure your child has everything they need when they arrive at school. This will help reduce classroom interruptions, traffic on campus as well as encourage greater responsibility. Late items will only be accepted until 8:30am. Late items include but are not limited to homework, lunch boxes, field trip forms, jackets, and water bottles.
- **Student IDs-**All students will be issued school IDs in the beginning of the year. These IDs are to be always worn while on campus. IDs will remain at school.
- Accessing Campus/Mandatory ID- All visitors to campus must show their ID when buzzing into the front office. You will be asked to show it again when you check into the front office to sign in.

School Uniforms

Park Springs is a participant of the mandatory
Unified Dress Code Program. All children must
wear their school uniform that follows the school's
dress code. Shopping for school uniforms? The

Apparel. Uniforms with the PSE logo are available
at this store only. Pick up and shipping are available.
Solid color polos, dresses, shorts, skorts and pants
may also be purchased at any retailer that sells uniform

styles such as Target, The Children's Place or Kohl's.



ARRIVAL

- The car line begins promptly at 7:15 daily. The line will be monitored to ensure that only Before Care cars are permitted to enter prior to 7:15.
- Please be sure to pull all the way forward and have your child ready to exit the vehicle on the passenger side. Do not stop while traffic is moving and let your child out.
- Please give hugs & kisses, backpacks, lunches, and water bottles prior to stopping. Please do not get out of your vehicle.
- For everyone's safety, students should only be dropped off in the car line.
- PLEASE, for the safety of the students, do not use your cell phone in the car line.
- Parents may walk their child to the gate. Only students will be permitted on campus through the gate.
- School starts at 7:45am. If you arrive after the car line is done and there are no adults outside, please park and sign your child in late through the front office.

DISMISSAL

- Students are dismissed at 1:45pm.
- All families will receive a CurbSmart tag. (Keep it in a safe spot.) If your family requires additional car hangers, please contact the front office.
- Please be sure your child's teacher has their dismissal information.
- ALL students will have a dismissal band on their backpack indicating their dismissal procedure.
- Parents are not permitted to walk up to dismiss a car rider.
- All cars <u>must display the CurbSmart car hanger</u>. Any cars that do not have hangers will be required to park and come in the front office to sign out their child, with ID.
- PLEASE, for the safety of the students do not use your cell phone in the car line.
- Walkers and bike riders will be dismissed through the East and West gate. Walkers and bike riders will not be permitted to leave campus if there is lightning in the area.
- Children riding buses will be escorted to their bus. Please be patient the first few days waiting for late buses.
- If you need to change your child's dismissal, you must notify the front office and teacher in writing. We are unable to take any dismissal changes after 1pm.
- Students may not be released for an early dismissal after 1:15 pm.
