The AICE curriculum requires a total of **SEVEN** AICE courses between grades 9-11 or grades 10-12 with at least one course and one exam from each of the three subject groupings, as well as one in the core group. Students may take as many AICE courses as desired, if there is a teacher recommendation and the minimum requirement (7) is met. AS exams count as one point toward the diploma. AL exams count as two points toward the diploma. You must earn the seven required credits during a 25-month period. Required courses are in bold.
