

-Staff and students wear pink or red to show love.


Monday, October 30th Scare Drugs Away*

Tuesday- October 31" Drugs are Scary. Stay Away!"


 Staff and students wear Halloween costumes and participate in school-wide Halloween parade.



Drownings are

quick and silent

- Drownings can happen in as little as a few seconds. Children who drown generally do not scream, splash or struggle.
- There are multiple layers of protection that can help prevent childhood drownings. These include door/window alarms, pool fences and gates.
- Many drownings occur when a child leaves the house undetected. It is important to keep close and constant supervision.
