

Apply for the 2020-2021 Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK)/Enrichment Program Now!





VPK/ ENRICHMENT GENERAL INFORMATION

VPK is a program available to children that will be 4 years old by September 1, 2020. We offer full day (VPK/Enrichment) programs, 7:30 a.m. — 2:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (exact hours may vary). All schools offer free breakfast. All teachers have a Bachelor's Degree or higher and have Florida certification specializing in Early Childhood Education.



VPK/ENRICHMENT TITLE I SELECTION

This VPK model consists of a **free**, **full school-day (6.5 hours)** of instruction available to children that live in a Title I school boundary. Seats are limited and selection is determined by eligibility criteria. Contact each school to learn about after school program availability



VPK ENRICHMENT (FEE SUPPORTED) RANDOM SELECTION

These schools offer both full day and half-day opportunities. Options include:

- Half Day 3 hours only (Free VPK) Seats are limited.
- Full Day 6.5 hours (VPK plus 3 hours of optional, fee-supported instruction).
