


## How to access the Public Participation Granicus Portal

1. Access the Granicus log-in: <a href="https://browardschools.granicusideas.com/users/sign\_in">https://browardschools.granicusideas.com/users/sign\_in</a>
click the sign in tab. If you don't have an account please click the "Don't have an account? No problem create one now!" tab.




2. If you don't have an account and you proceed to create an account the page below will populate. You would then need to provide the following information: valid email address, password, first and last name, city and zip code. Be sure to click the "I'm not a robot" captcha.

3. Once you're logged in, click on the *Meetings Tab* on the right to access upcoming and past agendas (circled in orange).






