Governor DeSantis Proposed Budget

Overview

Governor DeSantis' recommended budget was released on November 18, 2019.

Student Funding (FEFP)

- **Per-student Funding**: **\$7,979** (\$302/3.94% increase per student) state-wide **BCPS \$7,901** (\$256/3.36% increase per student).
- Base Student Allocation: <u>\$4,329</u> (\$50/1.17% increase per student).
- Safe Schools Allocation: <u>\$1.4 Million</u> increase state-wide (0.79%) for a total of \$181 million.
- **Mental Health Allocation:** <u>\$25 Million</u> increase state-wide (33.33%) for a total of \$100 million.
- \$600 million to raise the minimum teacher salary \$47,500.
- <u>\$300 million</u> for the new Florida Classroom Teacher and Principal Bonus program (replacing the Best and Brightest program).

Capital Improvement

- \$50 million for maintenance of public schools.
- \$173.9 million for maintenance of charter schools
- The budget includes \$50 million for the School Hardening Grant.
- The budget decreases the local millage tax rate by 0.126

Adults with Disabilities

The Governor's budget has included \$800,000 for the Adults with Disabilities-Broward County program. This is the same amount that was allocated last year.
