TIMELINE	AWARD TYPE	AWARD REQUIREMENT
March 11 - April 5, 2019	Outstanding Volunteer Awards	<ul> <li>To receive District recognition, schools must:</li> <li>Submit one (1) outstanding volunteer in one or all of the following award categories: adult, student, senior (age 55+) and program organizer</li> <li>Nominate individuals for the Years of Service Award. These volunteers consistently completed 200 or more hours per year at a BCPS school for the last 25, 20, 15, 10 and 5 years</li> </ul>
April 8 - May 13, 2019	Hour Service Lapel Pin Award	This award recognizes individual volunteers who donate a minimum of 200 hours of <b>accurately documented</b> service. Submit all service hours via the online form provided. Allow three weeks processing time.
March 22 - May 17, 2019	Golden School Award	To qualify for this state award, the school must have:  • A School Volunteer Liaison  • Staff training in volunteer utilization  • Recorded volunteer hours equal to at least twice the school's enrollment
March 22 – May 17, 2019	Silver School Award (For Secondary Schools Only)	<ul> <li>To qualify for this state award, the school must have:         <ul> <li>Student community service hours devoted to helping students learn, that are equal to one-half the FTE</li> <li>A designated coordinator at both the sending and the receiving schools</li> <li>Training for the students and staff</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
TBD	Five Star School Award	To qualify for this state award, the school must have the following programs: business partnership, family involvement, volunteers and school advisory council
