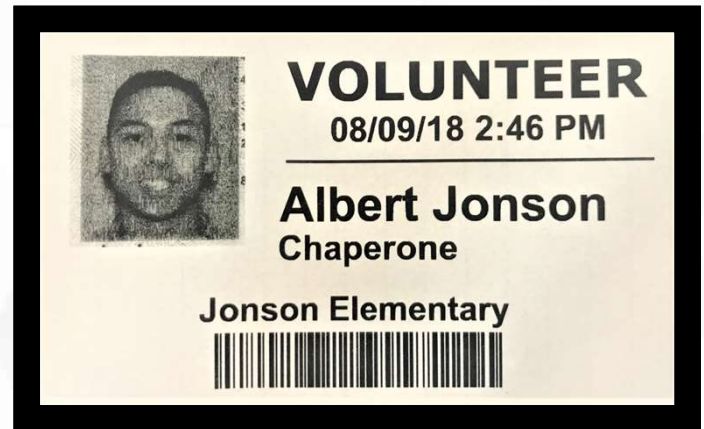
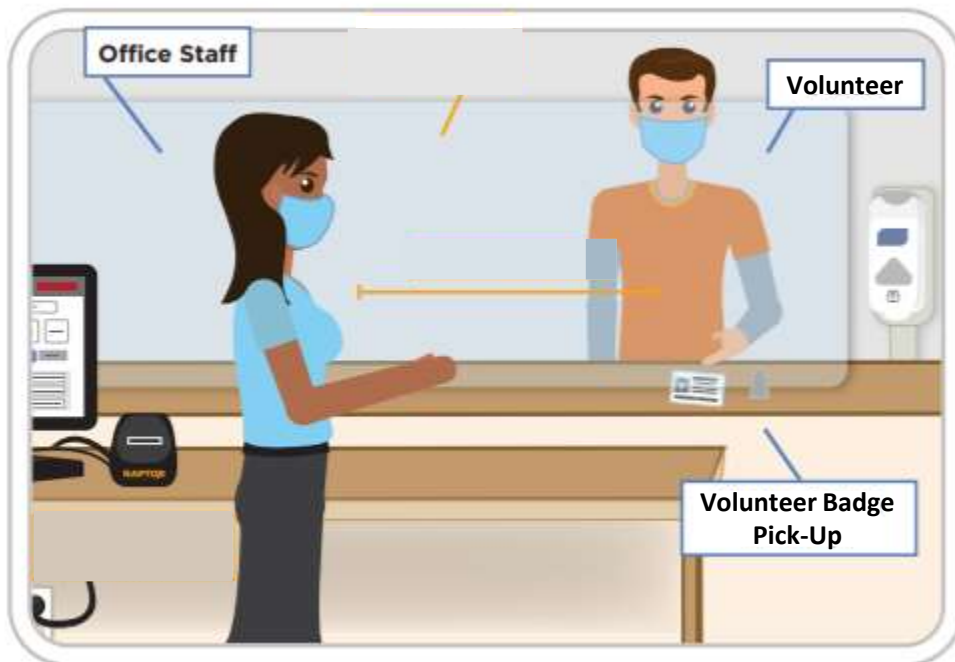



Level 1 and Level 2 Clearances

Level 1

- Online application
- Required for ALL volunteers
- Screened by the Security Clearance office
- Approval email sent
- Renew application annually

Level 2

- Fingerprinting
- Required for select volunteers
- Requested by school personnel
- Up to 10-day waiting period
- Valid for five years
- Renew personal information annually



Level 2 Clearance Information

- Level 2 clearance is ONLY for select volunteers such as overnight chaperones and band/athletic coaches
- Level 2 requests must ONLY include the following:
 - Name
 - Date of birth
 - School name
 - Specify role: overnight chaperone or band/athletic coach
- Volunteers must not contact the security clearance office for assistance unless their status is Inactive
- BCPS employees are level 2 cleared


