The Role of a BCPS Volunteer

Responsibilities of the School

- Train staff members on effective utilization of volunteers
- Survey school's needs for volunteer assistance
- Recruit and register volunteers
- Arrange for orientation and training
- Assign volunteers to specific role



Responsibilities of the School (continued)

- The School Volunteer Liaisons (SVLs) serves as a resource and advisor to school volunteers
- Create volunteer opportunities for individuals to participate in school-based activities and other activities
- Keep accurate records of volunteer services and hours
- Coordinate school recognition for volunteers
- Provide a welcoming environment for the community



Level 1 and Level 2 Clearances

Level 1

- Online application
- Renew application annually
- Automatically screened through Raptor
- Approval email sent
- Required for ALL volunteers,
 except BCPS employees
- View volunteers by running reports in Raptor

Level 2

- SVL/School personnel sends request to Security Clearance
- Online application and fingerprinting
- Up to 10-day waiting period
- Valid for five years; renew personal information annually
- View volunteers by checking the Security Clearance Filemaker Pro database










Welcome Page






Personal Information Page






Personal Information Page, Cont.






Confirmation Page






School Selection Page






School Selection Page – Using the Filter






Functions Page












Volunteer Portal – Hours






