## GENERAL INFORMATION

School staff, students, parents and community members may nominate Principals or Assistant Principals who exhibit outstanding talent for educational leadership in a complex and diverse environment.

## **SELECTION CRITERIA**

To be eligible for the Broward County **Principal/Assistant Principal of the Year** award, an individual:

- Must be a principal/assistant principal for a minimum of three full consecutive years
- Must have served at his/her school for the entire school year for which they are being nominated
- Evaluated as "effective" or "highly effective" on performance ratings as a principal/assistant principal
- In good standing in the school system
- \*Only candidates meeting the eligibility and selection criteria will be considered for the award.
