

Legislature's K-12 Budget for Fiscal Year 2015 - 2016

We received the legislature's budget conference report on June 19, 2015. The legislature provides more than \$781 million of additional funds for K-12 education in the State of Florida. Broward School District's share of the increase is approximately \$76 million. However, this increase includes the growth of 2,834 students. The actual increase is approximately \$56 million when the student growth is excluded from the increase.

Key financial highlights for Broward schools are as follows:

It should be noted that more than 66% of the increase will be funded by local taxes. For fiscal year 2015-2016, State funding makes up 52% of the total educational funding for Broward County. Additionally, the Broward per student funding is still \$57 below that of Fiscal Year 2008.
