

The Open Door Scholarship Program provides individuals an opportunity to enroll in a high-demand workforce program to gain critical skills needed in essential and emerging careers. This scholarship program is funded by the Florida Department of Education. Open Door Scholarship covers 100% of the cost for approved applicants associated with approved courses.

Funds from the program must be used to cover the cost of tuition, fees, examination, books, and materials.
